Dear Colleagues!

The Basic Organization of culture and languages of the CIS Member States – Moscow State Linguistic University, the Department of Languages and Cultures of the CIS and Near Abroad with the support of the Ministry of Education, Science, Culture and Sports of the Republic of Armenia, Embassy of Armenia to Russian Federation and LLC "The Union of Armenians of Russia" invites you to participate in the **International scientific-practical conference “Armenology in the context of languages and cultures”** that will be held on **18-19 of April 2023**.

Venue: Moscow State Linguistic University; Ostozhenka 36, room 205, Moscow, Russia.

The purpose of the Conference is to study the development and existence conditions of the Armenian language at all periods of human history (from ancient times to the present) and the ethnogenesis of the Armenian people.

Directions of the Conference work:

1. Traditions and Innovations in Methods of Teaching the Armenian Language and Literature.
2. The Armenian Language: Translation and Interpretation Challenges Nowadays.
3. Comparative-Historical Linguistics.
4. Intercultural Communication: Language and Thought.
5. Latest Research in Terminology of The Armenian Language: The Impact of Scientific and Technological Progress and Modern Conditions.

Scientists, professors, faculty members, heads of institutions of additional professional education, doctoral students, graduate and undergraduate students, representatives of international and public organizations are all invited to participate in the conference.

The official languages of the Conference are Armenian, Russian and English.

Forms of participation: In-person or remote (online).

The proceedings of the conference will be published in an electronic compendium with the assignment of ISBN and will be placed article by article in the RSCI base (Russian Science Citation Index).

Requirements for articles published in RSCI

- 1) The volume of the work has to be more than 3 pages;
- 2) Articles are presented in MS Word (doc or docx);
- 3) Visual information (pictures) is sent in jpg, bmp, gif file formats. Please, add some description to the files;
- 4) Text formatting (font size – 14 points, line spacing – 1.5 lines, paragraph indentation – 1 cm, alignment type – justify);
- 5) The article is accepted by the editors only after the assignment of the UDC (Universal Decimal Classification Index). It can be manually obtained on the official resource of the IIC Scientific Library;
- 6) Presence of a library-bibliographic classification is mandatory for RSCI publications.

The Procedure of Providing the Materials

It is necessary to send your application and article to armconforgcom@mail.ru organizing committee mail. The example of application form is given below.

Your application and the materials for publication should be named with your surname and initials. (Example: Ivanov I.V._application.docx; Ivanov I.V._article.doc). The filetype is doc* or docx*. If there are more than two authors, name the file after the first mentioned.

The organizing committee reserves the right to reject articles or applications that do not meet the above requirements or do not touch upon the directions of conference work.

Requirements for the Articles

Original, previously unpublished, articles of 5-8 pages of typewritten text and a list of references are accepted for publication.

Materials must be provided only in electronic form.

Every article is checked for plagiarism; only the articles with at least 75% uniqueness are accepted.

Universal Decimal Classification (UDC) number should be located in the upper left corner, at the beginning of the article.

The upper right corner should contain:

1. Surname and initials (in nominative case), place of work and the positions held by are written in non-bold font with right alignment. If there are authors from different institutions, the information about them should be written in the same way (non-bold font with right alignment).

2. The title of the article is written in three languages: Armenian, Russian and English. You should write it in capital letters, bold font, center alignment.

3. Abstract (100 words) is written with the font Times New Roman, font size - 12, line spacing - 1, the word “Abstract” is in bold, the text of the abstract is in non-bold. Word wrapping is not allowed.

4. Keywords (10 words or phrases) are placed after the abstract text. The phrase “Keywords” are written in bold, the keywords themselves – in non-bold, separated by commas. Word wrapping is not allowed.

The abstract and keywords are written in three languages: Armenian, Russian and English. For participants from abroad: in Russian and English.

5. All articles are provided in either Armenian, English or Russian.

6. Article has to include a list of references. Word wrapping is not allowed.

7. The article is provided in electronic form, Times New Roman 12, line spacing 1.5, paragraph indentation 1.25;

8. Margins on the left, right, top and bottom - 2 cm.

9. Links should look like [5, p. 67], the number of the source in the list of references and the page number in this source are indicated.
